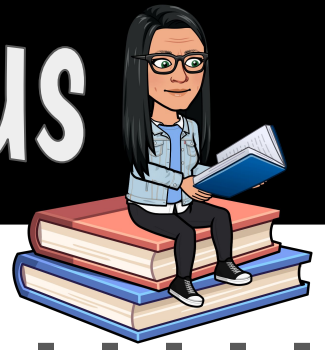


# Business Law Syllabus

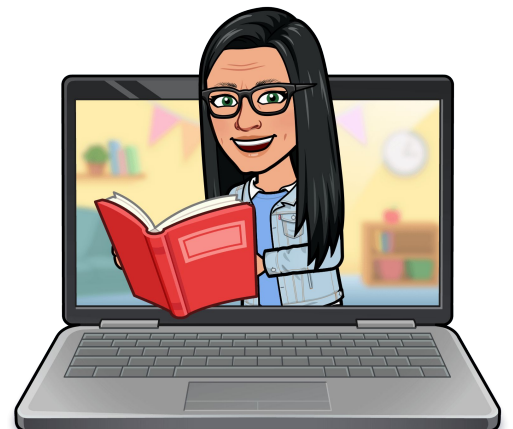

## GRADING

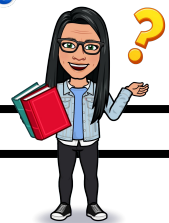
Grades are based on performance on projects and skill checks. All students will be demonstrating the learning to receive credit for the class. We will follow the grading scale from the RACTC.
