Welcome to Graphic Design & Photography! My name is Amanda Anderson and I will be your instructor this year! This course will introduce students to the skills needed in graphic design and photography. Students will be exposed to the elements and principles of design, photography, sketching, digital illustration, photo editing, and graphic design. Students will create a digital portfolio for their artwork and they will be introduced to the following Adobe Creative Cloud Software: Photoshop and Illustrator. Units will be based on the Print Ed competencies and the ND Graphic Communications Education Content Standards for introduction to Graphic Communications and Advertising Design.
